Bertha Helen LaMore, 93 of Columbus, NC passed away Sunday morning, May 12, 2019 at Smith Phayer Hospice House, Landrum, SC.

Born in Bloomington, IL, she was the daughter of the late Abraham Lincoln Woosley and Hazel Baber Woosley and wife of forty years to the late Melrose Michael LaMore who passed away in 1986 in Manteno. Mrs. LaMore had moved to North Carolina in April this year to be with her son and daughter-in-law, coming from Lakeland, FL where she resided for the past 30 years.

Helen had a 35-year career as a nurse and medical secretary for a family practice in Manteno.
