Carl L. Fletcher, 45, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday (Nov. 7, 2015) at his home.

He was born July 21, 1970, in Muskegon, Mich., the son of Max and Karen Scouten Fletcher, of Jackson, Mich. Carl married Camille Smith on July 25, 1992, in Racine, Wis.

Carl was a professor of communications at Olivet Nazarene University, Bourbonnais, and operations director at Shine.FM. He also was a board member for St. George Elementary School, St. George. Carl also was a man who was of deep faith.

He was a member of Manteno Church of the Nazarene, Manteno. He enjoyed coaching softball and basketball and spending time with his family. Carl received his MBA from Olivet Nazarene University and was working on his Doctorate at Regent University.

Survivors include his wife, of Bourbonnais; daughters, Caitlin Fletcher, Camryn Fletcher, Carly Fletcher, and Cara Fletcher, all of Bourbonnais; sister and brother-in-law, Deb and Mark Howard, of Bourbonnais; brother and sister-in-law, Brian and Jill Fletcher, of Jackson, Mich.; and many nieces, nephews and other family members.

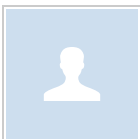
