Hildath Lucille Lawrence, 103, of Manteno, passed away Friday, February 21, 2020.

Hildath Lucille Lawrence was born on April 12, 1916. She was the fourth of four children and the only daughter of Neil C. Sloan and Lola Hanger Sloan. She was born at their home in Woodford County, Roanoke, Illinois. After growing up on the farm she moved to Manteno, Illinois.

She met a special guy, E. W. "Bud" Lawrence. They were married at the First Methodist Church in Kankakee, Illinois on May 15, 1936. They had three children, Norma Rae, Douglass Walter and David Bruce.
