



## Mildred "Millie" L. Eichmann Pudwell

June 7, 1925 - December 31, 2024

Mildred (Millie) Louise Eichmann Pudwell, formerly of Manteno and Grant Park, IL, passed peacefully on December 31, 2024, at the Park View Home in Woodville, WI, where she had lived since December 2019. She was 99 years young.

Millie easily made friends with both the staff and resident community. She was an outgoing person who often struck up conversations with strangers. Earlier in her life, she was a talented baker, and she generously shared this talent, baking cakes for family and friends.

Millie was born in Chicago, IL, on June 7, 1925. She was the daughter of Arthur Eichmann and Ida Schutt Eichmann. In 1945 Millie married Erich Pudwell at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Chicago where both of them had been baptized and confirmed. They celebrated 51 years of marriage.
