



## Walter J. Brust

July 2, 1929 - August 6, 2023

Walter J. Brust, age 94, peacefully passed away at his home on Sunday, August 6, 2023, surrounded by family.

He was born in Cairo, Illinois on July 2, 1929, the son of Elmer Leo and Freidaline (Baumgart) Brust. On November 5, 1949, he married Ruby F. Gaskill in Ullin, Illinois. He worked as a welder, a millright, retiring from Caterpillar Tractor, and did autobody work. He was also a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Manteno. Walter enjoyed traveling extensively in the US with Ruby, his wife, in their RV. He enjoyed watching NASCAR and collecting NASCAR memorabilia.
