William "Bill" Boudreau, 58, of Manteno, passed away Friday (Oct. 19, 2018) at his home.

He was born Oct. 3, 1960, at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee, the son of Robert Boudreau and Winnie Keigher Boudreau.

Bill worked at the Sears Warehouse, St. Joseph Cemetery (groundskeeping), Diversatech in Manteno (groundskeeping), and was a Manteno Township Trustee for 24 years.

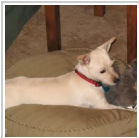
